ADOPTION OF RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES

AFFIDAVIT OF CORPORATE RESOLUTION of TURFWAY PARK HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION, INC.

Turfway Park Homeowners Association, Inc., by its Board of Directors, on this <u>5</u> day of <u>May</u>, 20 17, and states as follows:

INTRODUCTION:

The residential community in Johnson County, Indiana, commonly known as Turfway Park was established upon the recording of certain Plats and other documents with the Office of the Recorder for Johnson County, Indiana; and

The Plat for Turfway Park, Section 1A, was recorded with the Office of the Johnson County Recorder on July 9, 1997, as **Instrument # 97014747**, in Plat Book D, Page 56 A & B; and

The Plat for Turfway Park, Section 1B, was recorded with the Office of the Johnson County Recorder on October 29, 1998, as **Instrument # 98030628**, in Plat Book D, Page 155 A & B; and

The Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions of Turfway Park ("Declaration") was recorded with the Office of the Johnson County Recorder on May 13, 1997, as **Instrument # 97009683**; and



The Declaration states that by taking a deed to any Lot as set forth on the above listed Plats for the Turfway Park development, each owner becomes a mandatory member of the subdivision's homeowner's association known as Turfway Park Homeowners Association, Inc. ("Association"), an Indiana nonprofit corporation; and

The Association was incorporated as provided in the Declarations as a non-profit corporation by the Articles of Incorporation ("Articles") filed with, and approved by, the Indiana Secretary of State on May 15, 1997; and

The original Board of Directors adopted a Code of Bylaws ("Bylaws") for the Association to define the operating procedures of the Association and the powers and authority of the Board of Directors, said Bylaws being revised and amended from time to time thereafter; and

The Declaration, Article III, Section 3.1(c), and Article VI, Section 6.21, both state that the Board of Directors has the authority to adopt rules and regulations for the use, improvements, additions, and alterations of the Lots and any Common Areas owned by the Association; and

The Articles, Article II, Section 2.03(c), states that the Association shall have the power to adopt rules and regulations and to perform such deeds as are deemed necessary to achieve the aforesaid purposes; and

The Bylaws, Article V, Section 4(g), states that the Board of Directors of the Association has the power to create, adopt, revise, amend or alter from time to time such additional rules and regulations with respect to use, occupancy, operation, enjoyment, and architectural additions or modifications of the Property, including the individual lots, streets (whether public or private), and the Common Areas, said rules and regulations being in addition to the rules and restrictions set forth in the Declaration, as the Board, in its discretion, deems necessary or advisable; and

Following the authority cited above, the Board of Directors desires to adopt certain rules and regulations which it deems necessary and designed to protect the enjoyment, health, safety and welfare of the residents and the value, appearance and desirability of the properties within the Turfway Park community; and

 AS A RESULT, based on the authority granted to the Board of Directors by the Declaration, Articles, and Bylaws, a majority of the Board of Directors have voted to adopt these Rules. These Rules do not conflict in any manner with any provision in the Declaration, Articles, or Bylaws. The Rules is stated as follows:

COMMON AREA USE RULE

<u>for</u>

TURFWAY PARK

- 1. <u>USE AT OWN RISK</u>. Safety is of primary concern to the Association. All persons using the lakes, ponds and common areas do so at their own risk and agree, by their use of the common areas, to abide by the rules adopted by the Association. The Association, its Directors and agents, assume no responsibility for any accident, injury, or damage incurred in connection with use of the lakes, ponds or common areas. Residents are responsible for the actions of their children and guests.
- 2. **KEEP OUT OF WATER!** Owners, residents and their guests are strictly prohibited from entering the water of any lake or pond in Turfway Park at any time.
- 3. **KEEP OFF THE RIP RAP!** No Owner, resident or their guest may walk on, move or remove the rip rap stone around any of the lakes and ponds at any time.
- 4. OWNERS, RESIDENTS AND GUESTS ONLY. The lakes, ponds and surrounding areas are for the exclusive use of Turfway Park Owners, their family members and guests. To prevent overcrowding, only three (3) guests may fish per Owner.
- 5. **FISHING.** Fishing in the lakes and ponds in Turfway Park is limited to bank or shoreline fishing only. Fishing is restricted to pole and rod fishing only. No other devices for catching fish are allowed.
- 6. CATCH & RELEASE ONLY. Because the lakes and ponds serve as a collection point for street water drainage and other runoff, the Association would ask all residents to strictly follow a "catch and release" policy when fishing in the lakes and ponds.
- 7. HOURS FOR FISHING. Fishing is allowed during daylight hours only.
- 8. NO ICE SKATING, ICE FISHING, BOATING OR SKIING. No ice skating, ice fishing, boating or skiing is allowed on the lakes and ponds.
- 9. NO TRESPASSING. No Owner, resident or their guest(s) may trespass upon the private property of another Owner to fish unless that property Owner has granted the Owner, resident or guest permission to fish from the Owner's bank.

133	10. NO LITTERING. Residents are not to litter on or destroy any portion of the
134	common areas or the private property areas that boundary the common areas.
135	PLEASE BE COURTEOUS OF OTHERS!
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137	11. NO WEAPONS! No Owner, resident or their guest may use or shoot weapons of
138	any kind, including guns, air guns, paint guns, bb guns, bows/arrows, etc. on or
139	around the lakes, ponds or any common areas at any time.
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141	12. NO MOTORIZED VEHICLES! No Owner, resident or their guest may operate a
142	motorized vehicle, including 4-wheelers, go-carts, motorcycles, etc. on or around the
143	lakes, ponds or any common area at any time.
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145	13. BAD BEHAVIOR. Profane language and shouting are prohibited while using the
146	ponds, lakes and common areas. No roughhousing, shoving or fighting is permitted
147	around the pond, lake or any common area.
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149	14. VIOLATIONS. If any Owner, resident or their guest(s) do not obey these rules, the
150	Association has the right to prohibit you from using the pond and lake areas. Also, if
151	a resident or his guest damages the pond or lake areas or any private property, the
152	Owner will be responsible for reimbursing the Association, or the private property
153	Owner, for the damage repair or replacement costs, including legal fees if legal action
154	becomes necessary.
